Purpose: To establish a procedure for safe and effective use of Rapid Sequence.

Scope: This procedure is to be followed by all paramedics of the Mukwonago Fire Department. Authority to deviate from this procedure rests with the senior paramedic in charge who will be responsible for the results of any deviation.

A. Rapid Sequence Intubation

1. Shall be done in accordance with current Waukesha County EMS Guidelines (Guideline 2018).

B. Medication storage and use:

1. All medications used for RSI will be kept in a zippered case and sealed with a number lock.
2. Following use, RSI medication sheet must be filled out noting the old and new seal numbers.
3. All refrigerated medications (Succinylcholine / Rocuronium) must be exchanged every 60 days if not kept in a refrigerated environment.

C. Training:

1. All paramedics will be trained to risk stratify airway management options.
2. All paramedics will be trained on the use of RSI procedure and medications.
3. All paramedics must attend quarterly scenario trainings that include airway management, RSI procedure and post intubation management.
