Purpose: The purpose of this guideline is to define the minimum apparatus and order of response required for incidents involving the fire department.

Also reference EMS response in SOG #1

Scope: This guideline is to be followed by all officers and members of this department. Authority to deviate from this procedure rests with the officer in charge of the incident who will be responsible for the results of any deviation.

A. Motor Vehicle Crash:

1. Primary Ambulance
2. Extrication Engine
3. If staffing allows:
 - a. Paramedic Response Vehicle
 - b. Additional Ambulance
 - c. Additional Engine
4. Additionally, the following should respond considering the location of the Motor Vehicle Crash:
 - a. Ladder truck for blocking traffic on any multi-lane road or interstate

B. Investigation:

1. Engine and ambulance.
2. Ladder truck and additional engine, if staffing allows.

C. Outside fire:

1. Engine, ambulance, tender (if in Town, in non-hydrant area).
2. Additional engine.

D. Structure fires:

1. Engine, Ladder, Ambulance, Tender (non-hydrant locations)
2. 2nd Engine, Command Vehicle
3. If staffing allows:
 - a. 3rd Engine
 - b. Pick-up
 - c. Ambulance

E. Water/Ice Rescue:

1. Water rescue vehicle
2. Boat (open water) and or ATV (ice or open water)
3. Ambulance x2
4. Paramedic response vehicle
5. Engine

F. Grass fire:

1. Grass truck, ATV, engine, tender, ambulance.
2. Additional engine, pick-up, additional ambulance, command vehicle.

G. Hazardous Materials Response:

1. Engine, ambulance, command vehicle.
2. Ladder, additional engine, tender, additional ambulance.
3. City of Waukesha Hazardous Materials Team.

H. MABAS/Mutual Aid:

1. Apparatus that is requested by dispatch.

I. Missing Person(s) Search:

1. ATV, Ambulance, engine, pick-up.
2. Additional equipment as requested by command.

J. Southern Waukesha RIT (SWR):

1. Engine supplying RIT equipment (pick-up/grass truck for additional personnel).

K. Natural disaster:

1. Engine and ambulance.
2. Additional equipment as requested by command.
