**Construction accidents**

**PURPOSE:** To establish procedures for maximizing fire fighter and EMS personnel safety when responding and dealing with emergency medical calls.

**SCOPE:** This procedure is to be followed by all officers and members of this department. Authority to deviate from this procedure rests with the EMS Assistant Chief or Chief of the Department who will be responsible for the results of any deviation.

- A. The Mukwonago Fire Department will be responding along with EMS calls to any construction accident(s).
- B. During the daytime, it will be a Fire Department response.
- C. During the nighttime, it will be the duty company on call who will respond.
- D. Vehicles responding will be determined by the officer in charge. A minimum apparatus response in the following order will be:  
  
Paramedic vehicle, Engine, Aerial Platform, ATV and an ambulance.

**Release from the Station**

- A. After each call, members that responded for that call can be released from the station once they have been cleared by the officer in charge.
- B. All vehicles must be restocked and washed prior to any member leaving the station.
- C. If a member needs to leave the station prior to the vehicles being back in service, that member must talk to the officer in charge.

## **Emergency response to special events**

- A. The Mukwonago Fire Department will be responding to EMS calls at, but not limited to, the following events:
  - 1. Maxwell Street Days
  - 2. Summerfeste
  - 3. St. James Festival
  - 4. Midnight Magic
  - 5. Fireworks
- B. The response will be the minimum of an ambulance and an engine company.
- C. Nighttime response will be handled by the duty company on call and daytime response will be a Fire Department response.
