PURPOSE: To provide a guideline for maximizing firefighter safety at a structure fire by way of initiating a Rapid Intervention Crew (RIC) response.

SCOPE: This procedure is to be followed by all officers and members of this department. Authority to deviate from this procedure rests with the officer in charge of the incident who will be responsible for the results of any deviation.

- A. A Rapid Intervention Crew (RIC) response should be initiated as early as possible upon receiving a call such as:
 - 1. Structure fire
 - 2. Structure failure
- B. To initiate a RIC response, request dispatch to contact Waukesha County Communications (WCC) to have SWR RIC to respond to the incident.
- C. When using the MABAS Box Alarm System, a RIC response is built into a box alarm.
